Weekly Review

- Fraud Activity reported after the victim received a phone call demanding \$3,000.00 immediately or her family would be harmed. She complied.
- Theft from Vehicle reported at 15XXX Kendale Drive.
- Fraud Activity reported after a female provided \$5,500.00 to a male she met on a dating website. After he made demands for an additional \$27,000.00 she refused and called to report and document the incident.
- Officers responded to 15XXX Dupont Avenue on a report of Burglary. The suspect(s) entered the garage and stole a TV and game system.
- Similar Fraud Activity was reported, just we've recently seen and highlighted here. The victim received a phone call from someone identifying themselves as an Officer with the Sheriff's Office. The "Officer" then indicates a Warrant needs to be taken care of immediately by wiring funds. Fortunately, the victim didn't take the bait.
- Suspicious Activity reported at 21XXX Kenrick Avenue after counterfeit currency was recovered.
- Fraud Activity reported by a victim who was asked to deposit a check and then immediately take out \$1,500.00 and give it to the suspect. The check bounced and the victim is out the funds.
- Officers mediated a Domestic Dispute between two parties who were arguing over money being lent to a family member.
- Patrol arrested a 26-year old male for 5th Degree Domestic Assault.
- Fraud Activity reported after the victim believes he was scammed out of \$70,000.00 by a female he connected with on a dating website.
- Theft from Vehicle reported at 16XXX Ipava Avenue after a wallet was stolen.
- Officers responded to a Fraud Activity in Progress report at 17XXX Kenrick Avenue. Two (2) male suspects were found concealing items and were taken into custody outside of the store. The suspects used a stolen credit card to purchase a TV. The credit card had just been reported stolen yesterday from another suburb. Both males were jailed.
- Traffic Stop, at 173rd Street West and Pilot Knob Road, resulted in the 3rd Degree DWI arrest of a 21-year old male after he provided a .17 DMT.
- Traffic Stop, at Pilot Knob Road and 170th Street West, found the 28-year old female driver impaired. She was arrested for 2nd Degree Refusal and 3rd Degree DWI.
- Traffic Stop on 202nd Street West and Hamburg, for Speeding, resulted in the DWI arrest of a 23-year old male.
