- Theft of a large amount of copper reported from 8XXX 209th Street West.
- Patrol responded to no less than ten (10) Mental Health Crisis calls.
- Theft of a firearm and laptop computer reported from 17XXX Gillette Way.
- A motorcycle, driven by an adult male, was struck by a vehicle as he was pulling onto Dodd from Hyde Park. Fortunately, the accident wasn't fatal. The motorcyclist suffered a severe head laceration and possible broken nose. He was transported to the hospital for care.
- Patrol responded to a Harassment call and responded to/mediated a dispute in which one neighbor is angry over the other's loud car.
- Vandalism reported to a vehicle at 16XXX Fishing Way.
- Officers responded to two males who wanted to turn themselves in on Warrants. A 21-year old male and 20-year old male both had outstanding Theft Warrants. They were jailed without incident.
