- Officers were called to check on Suspicious Activity on Knollwood. Contact was made with a 21-year old male with an outstanding Dakota County Theft Warrant. He was jailed.
- Patrol responded to no less than five (5) Mental Health Crisis calls.
- Harassment reported after the victim met someone on social media. That person is now threatening to send a sensitive video to family and friends if demands aren't met.
- Theft from Vehicle reported from 20XXX Frost Court. Building supplies were stolen.
- Vandalism/Property Damage reported at 16XXX Kenyon Avenue. An unknown suspect broke the passenger side window on a van.
- A 38-year old male was cited for employee Theft from 17XXX Kenrick Avenue.
- Officers responded three separate times, one evening this week, to deal with a very intoxicated 48-year old male. He was arrested for Disorderly Conduct.
- Fraud Activity reported after the victim sent a large amount of money to a business contact who promised help starting up a small business. Now the partner isn't following through.
- Responding to an Indecent Exposure call, Patrol interviewed a 32-year old male suspect who admitted to exposing himself in his vehicle. He was booked at LPD and released with Citations for Indecent Exposure and Disorderly Conduct.
- Theft of cash reported from 17XXX Kenwood Trail.
- Fraud Activity reported after the victim became involved in a phone scam involving fraudulent gift cards.
- Patrol was called out to Kenyon Avenue on a Verbal Domestic. Several of the parties involved had outstanding Warrants. A 41-year old male, 31-year old female and 37-year old male were taken into custody.
- Traffic Stop at I-35 and 210th Street West resulted in the 3rd Degree DWI arrest of a 26-year old male. He was found impaired and drinking from a beer bottle. His DMT was .17.
