## Lakeville Police Department Update Sunday, May 05 – Saturday, May 11, 2019 Weekly Review

- A 46-year old female drove her vehicle into several cars, ultimately parking in a lot at 16XXX Pilot Knob. Shortly after, she fled the scene. She was stopped, found to be impaired and arrested for DWI.
- Patrol assisted with a Traffic Accident, on 185<sup>th</sup> Street West and Kenrick Avenue, involving a dump truck that had tipped onto the side and had released concrete/steel onto the roadway.
- Patrol witnessed a 31-year old female make a Stop-Arm Violation on 165<sup>th</sup> Street West and she was cited.
- Officers, including Apple Valley K-9 and State Patrol, responded to a Robbery in Progress call on Cedar and Dodd. The victim reported a male came into the store with a bandana covering his face, brandishing a handgun and demanding money. The till was later recovered by Patrol. The investigation is ongoing.
- CSO's provided traffic assistance at the 185<sup>th</sup> and Ipava traffic light after a power outage caused the lights to go out.
- Patrol responded to a Traffic Accident at 210<sup>th</sup> Street West and Hamburg Avenue after a 33-year old male slammed the car he was driving into a tree. He was transferred to the hospital with non-life-threatening injuries.
- Theft from Vehicle reported at 20XXX Jutland Place after an unlocked vehicle was entered.
- Burglary of a shed reported at 8XXX 202<sup>nd</sup> Street West.
- Officers responded to a Domestic/Disputes report and arrested a 30-year old female for Domestic Assault.
- Theft of a bicycle reported from 17XXX North Creek Drive.
- Officers responded to a Weapons call and assisted Farmington PD with a Felony stop. A 20-year old was jailed on GM Pointing a Dangerous Weapon, Receiving Stolen Property and Felon in Possession of a Weapon. The 18-year old driver of the suspect vehicle was jailed on 5<sup>th</sup> Degree Possession and No MN DL.
- Officers responded to a Driving Complaint and located the vehicle on Glasgow Avenue. The 55-year old male driver was intoxicated, failing sobriety tests, and later provided a .299 DMT. He was jailed on 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree DWI.
- Vandalism/Property Damage reported at 20XXX Italy Avenue. An unknown suspect damaged a vehicle's gas tank. Fast forward later that same day and Patrol was dispatched on a Suspicion call. They located a 47-year old male and arrested him for 1<sup>st</sup> Degree Criminal Damage to Property after discovering evidence in his possession related to the crime.
- Theft from Vehicle occurred from an unlocked vehicle at King Park. A purse, and wallet containing \$500.00 in cash, was stolen.
