Weekly Review

- This week may have been a record for DWI arrests in our City. For the safety of yourself, and everyone else, please secure a designated driver if you're going to be out having fun. And, if you're on the roadways and see something, say something. Several of these incidents were called in by concerned citizens. Thank you to them!
 - Traffic Stop, at Kenrick Avenue and Kenwood Trail, resulted in the 22-year old male driver found to be Revoked and displaying signs of impairment. He was arrested for 4th Degree DWI.
 - After receiving Driving Complaints of a south-bound vehicle on Cedar Avenue, Patrol located the car and attempted a stop. The driver engaged in a pursuit and went off the road, taking out a few garbage cans in the process. The 18-year old female driver was impaired. She was jailed on eight (8) separate charges.
 - DWI arrest of a 25-year old male, at 172nd Street and Steven Lane, who was not only impaired but also Revoked.
 - Traffic Stop, at 172nd Street West and Kenyon Avenue, resulted in the 2nd Degree DWI arrest of a 28-year old male after he submitted a .20 DMT.
 - Traffic Stop, on Holyoke Avenue and 210th Street West, resulted in the DWI arrest of a 36-year old male.
 - Traffic Stop, on Cedar Avenue and 161st Street West, resulted in the 3rd Degree DWI arrest of a 29-year old female.
 - A 50-year old female was arrested on Keokuk Avenue for 2nd Degree DWI. She tested a .20 BAC.
 - Traffic Stop, at 162nd Street West and Kenrick Avenue, resulted in the 3rd Degree DWI arrest of a 26-year old male.
 - A concerned citizen reported a vehicle swerving on Dodd Boulevard and 185th Street West. The 27-year old female driver was found intoxicated, providing a .19 BAC. She was arrested for 2nd Degree DWI.
 - Another citizen reported a vehicle all over the roadways, and nearly in the ditch, on Kenwood Trail and I-35. The 20-year old driver was found to be impaired, testing a .12 BAC, and arrested for 4th Degree DWI.
 - An off-duty officer called in a vehicle driving erratically on Ipava Avenue and 175th Street West. The 26-year old driver was arrested for 4th Degree DWI.
- Theft from Vehicle reported from an unlocked vehicle at 21XXX Dodd Boulevard. Fraudulent charges were conducted on two of the stolen credit cards.
- A 28-year old female was arrested for Assault.
- Patrol responded to no less than eight (8) Mental Health Crisis calls.
- Vandalism/Property Damage reported at 7XXX Upper 167th Street West after the victim discovered all the air was let out of her tires overnight.
- A lawn mower was reported stolen from 20XXX Hamburg Avenue.
- A north-bound dump truck on Dodd, driving with its rear all the way up, took out the light standards at 185th Street and Dodd Boulevard (see photo). The impact caused the truck to roll onto its side. Fortunately, no injuries were sustained. All the lights at the intersection were shut off until repairs can be made.

- Theft of a scooter reported from 17XXX Gettysburg Way.
- A crosswalk detail resulted in 1 driver warned at 205th and Juno Trail, 1 driver arrested (the driver was also Driving After Cancellation) and 2 others warned at Holyoke Avenue (south of 207th Street West) and 7 drivers warned at Holyoke Avenue and 208th Street.
- Severe weather took its toll on the City June 04 (see photos). Between 1630 and 1930 hours, Patrol had dozens of calls stacked to include three (3) house fires caused by lightening. Significant flooding caused major issues on Dodd Boulevard and Ipava Avenue, near LNHS. Several vehicles were almost completely submerged in those areas.
- Theft of mail reported from 16XXX Hominy Path.
- Theft of a trailer reported from 20XXX Cedar Avenue.
- Two drivers became involved in a road-rage incident that wound up in our front lot. Investigation ongoing.
- A 55-year old male was arrested for Domestic Assault, Strangulation and Interfere with 911.
