Weekly Review

- Patrol responded to no less than eleven (11) Mental Health Crisis calls.
- Officers responded to a Hit and Run crash. The suspect crashed into a vehicle and backed into a fire hydrant before ditching his car and running home. Officers tracked the 49-year old male down and he was arrested for DWI, along with a host of other charges.
- A concerned citizen reported a suspect driving drunk. The 54-year old female was stopped after she couldn't stay in her lane. She was jailed on 3rd Degree Test Refusal.
- Driving Complaint resulted in the 2nd Degree DWI arrest of a 25-year old male who tested a .24 BAC.
- Traffic Stop at 162nd Street West and Kenrick Avenue resulted in the 2nd Degree DWI arrest of a 44-year old female. She tested a .18 BAC.
- Patrol responded to a Traffic Accident, on Godson Drive, after a driver took the corner too fast and ran into a parked car. The at-fault driver was cited.
- Theft of a purse reported from an unlocked vehicle at 16XXX Fallbrook Drive.
- Theft from Vehicle and Vandalism reported at 7XXX 210th Street West.
- Following a report by a concerned citizen, a 22-year old female driver was stopped on 165th Street West and Ipava Avenue. She was driving all over the road, hitting curbs. At one point, it was reported she drove onto a yard to turn around. She tested a .26 BAC and was jailed on 3rd Degree DWI.
- A 21-year old male was cited for Shoplifting after attempting to steal merchandise, valued at \$200.00, from Target.
- An 18-year old male was cited for attempting to steal a case of beer at 20XXX Dodd Boulevard.
- Responding to a Drunkenness call, Officers arrested a 25-year old female for 5th Degree Domestic.
- Theft from Vehicle reported from 21XXX Ivory Lane. A wallet, including cash and gift cards, was stolen from an unlocked vehicle.
- Theft reported from 12XXX 205th Street West. Two kayaks were taken.
- Theft from Vehicle reported at 11XXX 210th Street West. A wallet was taken.
- Multiple drivers phoned in a vehicle driving erratically. An attempted Traffic Stop turned into a pursuit that continued into Scott County. The 20-year old male driver was located and taken into custody without further incident. He showed signs of impairment and was in possession of suspected MJ Wax. He was processed for DWI and a host of other charges.
- Vandalism/Property Damage reported to a boat at 20XXX India Avenue.
- A 25-year old female phoned 911, asking for help getting out of her car. She had just flipped over on the CR-50 off-ramp and was hanging upside down. By her own admission, she was impaired. Fortunately, her injuries were minor. She was taken to the hospital for evaluation and DWI charges are pending blood test results.
