Weekly Review

- Patrol responded to no less than nine (9) Mental Health Crisis calls.
- Theft from Vehicle reported from 18XXX Huxley Avenue. A wallet was taken from an unlocked vehicle.
- A trailer was reported stolen from 20XXX Holt Avenue.
- Vandalism/Property Damage reported at 20XXX Italy Avenue.
- A trucking company reported an enclosed semi-trailer, empty of cargo, stolen from 11XXX 210th Street West last month.
- Fraud reported after the victims discovered several thousand dollars written against their checking account.
- A 47-year old male drove his truck off the roadway and passed out behind the wheel. Patrol responded, after a concerned citizen called it in. The driver failed sobriety tests and was arrested for DWI.
- Bicycles were reported stolen from 16XXX Equestrian Trail.
- The entire shift responded to a Car vs Deer on Kenrick Avenue. The deer bolted out in front of traffic, was struck by one vehicle and landed through the windshield of another vehicle travelling in the opposite direction. Both passengers in that vehicle were transported to the hospital, one of which was airlifted. Our thoughts continue with the family as we hope for a full recovery.
- After failing to move over on a traffic stop, a vehicle was stopped on Cedar Avenue and Upper 167th Court West. The 22-year old male driver was found to be impaired, testing a .13 BAC. He was booked for DWI.
- Responding to a Driving Complaint of a vehicle going 5 MPH and still striking curbs, Patrol located the vehicle on Dodd Boulevard and Cedar Avenue. The 28-year old male was intoxicated and provided a .16 sample. He was jailed for 3rd Degree DWI.
