

NEW! FULL WEEK OPTION FOR THEATER CAMP PARTICIPANTS

Sign up for full-week or half-day camps. Half-day camp hours/fees are specified in each of the descriptions below (half days do not include gap care). Full-day camp hours (art in the morning and theater in the afternoon) are as follows:

Mon.-Thu. 9 a.m. – 5 p.m.

The fee for the full-week camp (\$190) includes morning art camp, afternoon theater camp and gap care. Since the afternoon rehearsal times vary depending on your child's part, we will provide gap care during non-rehearsal times.
