BEGINNING

Student has no experience or needs instruction with basic skills.

INTERMEDIATE/ADVANCED

Student has a basic understanding of wedging, centering and trimming. Student is interested in experimenting with a variety of techniques and is able to work independently.

POTTERY: WHEEL-THROWING & HAND-BUILDING

Ages 15+
