### Weekly Review

- Patrol responded to a Domestic call and charged an 18-year old male with 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree Assault.
- Responding to a Domestic/Disputes in Progress, a 51-year old male was arrested for Domestic Assault.
- Officers responded to an injury Traffic Accident, at Kenrick Avenue and Junelle Path. The female driver, who ran a red light, was transported to the hospital for airbag related injuries. She was also cited.
- Patrol responded to a Suspicion call involving a male attempting to break into vehicles. After locating the suspect's vehicle, it was found to be an active Stolen. The 22-year old male was jailed on Possession of Stolen Property, Driving after Revocation and Tamper with Motor Vehicle.
- Theft reported from 16XXX Lions Court. Several tools were stolen from the construction site.
- Mail Theft reported from 11XXX 172<sup>nd</sup> Street West.
- Officers responded to a T-Bone Traffic Accident, at Dodd Boulevard and 194<sup>th</sup> Street West. Fortunately, there were only minor injuries.

- Fraud Activity reported after the victim sold a pair of jeans on-line and received a check for \$1,700.00. She returned \$1,500.00 of the money, only to find the check was bad. Unfortunately, someone is wearing a new pair of jeans with deeper pockets.
- A 26-year old female was cited from Misdemeanor Theft at Fleet Farm.
- Theft was reported from 20XXX Heritage Drive. After she walked into the store, a male and female suspect cornered the victim. While the male suspect spoke to the victim, creating a distraction, the female suspect took her wallet. The victim didn't realize the theft until she got to the checkout. The loss is valued at approximately \$1,400.00.
- Patrol conducted a routine Traffic Stop and the vehicle came back as a confirmed Stolen. The 19-year old male driver and his 30-year old female passenger were detained. The male was later booked into jail on Stolen Vehicle and Drug Possession charges.
- Patrol assisted LFD with a Structure Fire at 17XXX Jalisco Lane. Fortunately, there were no injuries reported. The home sustained moderate fire, smoke and water damage.
