Weekly Review

- A 40-year old male was cited for Illegal Dumping, after the reporting party observed him dumping garbage in a roll-off container that wasn't his own.
- A vehicle pulled out in the SB lane of CR-50, from SB 175th, not seeing a motorcycle SB on CR-50. The motorcyclist dumped the bike and, fortunately, the driver and passenger only sustained scrapes. The at-fault car driver was cited.
- Patrol responded to no less than eight (8) Mental Health Crisis calls.
- Mail Theft reported from 6XXX Lower 161st Street West.
- Burglary in Progress was reported at 7XX Juliet Drive. Upon Patrol's arrival, two subjects fled the area. One 44-year old male was apprehended and released.
- Theft from Vehicle reported at:
 - two (2) separate addresses at 17XXX Idlewood Way
 - 17XXX Inland Loop
- Property Damage was reported by Fleet Farm after a male driver struck the guard gate, with his vehicle, causing damage.
- Patrol responded to a Traffic Accident at 7XXX Grinnell Way. A 62-year old female was crossing the road when she was struck by a vehicle coming around the corner. She was transported to the hospital with non-life-threatening injuries. The 23-year old male driver was cited.
- Officers responded to a Domestic call and jailed a 27-year old male for Domestic-Fear.
- Patrol observed a vehicle blocking the road at 185th and Cedar. Upon seeing the squad, the 21-year old male driver proceeded forward and struck the curb a few times. He was stopped and arrested on a host of charges, including Cancelled-IPS (Inimical to Public Safety) and Felony DWI.
- Theft was reported from 17XXX Kenrick Avenue after two (2) unknown males stole several cartons of cigarettes.
