Weekly Review

- Responding to an alarm, at 21XXX Kenrick Avenue, Officers arrested a 30-year old male for Possession of Stolen Property and Felon in Possession of a Firearm.

- Officers responded to a Domestic call and arrested a 37-year old male for 5th Degree Domestic Assault.
- Fraud Activity reported by a victim who attempted to purchase a cat online. She prepaid the seller and was given a pick-up address in another suburb. The resident at that address advised there were no cats for sale there and that the victim was the second person that day to try and pick up a cat!
- Officers responded to a 911 call, at 7XXX 210th Street West, involving a male subject outside with a gun. The 57-year old male was unknown to the residents and had been seen in the area over the course of a few days. He was ultimately jailed on Terroristic Threats charges.
- A Driving Complaint, of an erratic driver, led to the DWI arrest of a 31-year old female, at Dodd Boulevard and Pilot Knob Road. She tested a .18 DMT. Her 29-year old female passenger was passed out in the front seat, covered in her own vomit. Both were transported to the hospital for medical care.
