Weekly Review

- Patrol responded to no less than nine (9) Mental Health Crisis calls.
- Officers were called to a Suspicion call regarding unknown persons walking around at night, with a flashlight, at a home under construction at 8XXX 180th Street West. Upon arrival, they discovered three 18-year old's, one female and two males, who received a host of violations including Underage Consumption, Possession of Alcohol and Trespass.
- Vandalism/Property Damage was reported at 17XXX Iberia Avenue. An unknown suspect(s) spray painted on the street, stop sign and an electrical box.
- A 35-year old male was arrested for GM violation of a Domestic Abuse No Contact Order.
- A 28-year old male was arrested for 5th Degree Domestic Assault.
- A 48-year old male was arrested for GM Interfere with 911 and Domestic Assault.
- Vandalism/Property Damage reported at Griffon Trail and Grenoble Avenue. An unknown suspect(s) spray painted the street.
- Patrol responded to a Traffic Accident, at Pilot Knob Road and Country View Trail, involving a motorist and a bicyclist. The cyclist suffered minor injuries.

- A 22-year old female was arrested for 5th Degree Domestic Assault.
