Canoe/Kayak Rack Application & Rental Agreement

- Rentals open on **March 15** OR the first business day following March 15 at **8:30 a.m.** online or via the phone.
- Canoe /Kayak rack rentals are available to **Lakeville residents** from April 1-November 30.
- Racks are not intended for year round storage, watercraft must be removed by November 30.
- Racks are on a first come, first served basis with no waitlist option.
- Seasonal rental rate is \$75, limit of one rack per household

Policy

- The Lakeville Parks & Recreation Department will only recognize the person whose signature appears on the application as being the responsible holder of said rack. **THERE IS NO SUBLETTING OF RACKS.**
- Watercraft must be securely fixed to the rack on both sides. The City will not be responsible for the damage to or the theft or disappearance of any watercraft permitted under this application.
- Watercraft must be removed by **November 30** each year. There is a \$50 retrieval fee if Parks removes watercraft with a \$25 per month storage fee. Watercraft is forfeit after three months of storage.

Canoe/Kayak Rack Rental Rules

Racks are available for watercraft defined as canoes, kayaks and sailboards. Canoe rack rentals are from **April 1 to November 30**. Please Note: Space is limited. The Lakeville Parks Department cannot guarantee the assignment of a rack to all applicants.

APPLICANTS: Canoe/kayak rack rentals are only available to Lakeville residents. Racks will be available for purchase online or via phone starting **March 15** or the first business day following if the date falls on a Saturday/Sunday. Due to high demand, there is a limit of 1 rack per household. Watercraft must be removed from the racks no later than November 30 each season. If it is not removed, Parks Department staff will cut the lock and remove the watercraft and place it in storage. If Parks Department staff must remove the watercraft, there will be a \$50 fee to retrieve your watercraft from storage and \$25 per month storage fee. Please call to arrange pickup. If the watercraft is not claimed after three months, craft will be forfeited to the City and sold.

PERMIT HOLDER: The Lakeville Parks Department will recognize only the person whose signature appears on the application as being the responsible holder of said rack. At no time may this individual sublease or receive remuneration for the use of their leased rack without acquiring authorization from the Parks Department.

PERMITS TO BONAFIDE WATERCRAFT OWNER ONLY: No permit shall be issued to anyone except a bonafide watercraft owner, who certifies on the form provided that the address stated is their legal residence and the watercraft to be registered is seaworthy. Suitable identification of the watercraft must be made in the application, including color and manufacturer's number, if possible. The owner must also furnish a current MN State watercraft registration number.

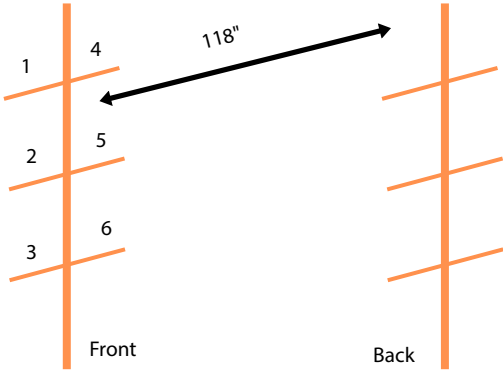
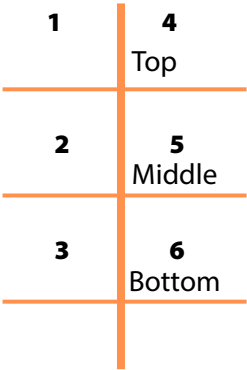
STATE LICENSE: Effective Jan. 1, 1972 watercraft used in the State of MN must be registered with the state.

SECURING OF CRAFT: Please be sure to place your canoe on the correct rack. It is mandatory that the owner of the craft purchase and maintain their own securing device. The device must be capable of securing BOTH the front and the rear of the craft to prevent damage to the craft, City rack and watercraft of others. Failure by the owner of any watercraft to maintain their securing device may result in damages for bodily injury or property damage payable to the City or both. The City does not warrant or certify the type or quality of the securing device selected by the owner nor the maintenance by the owner. The City will not be responsible for the damage to or the theft or disappearance of any watercraft permitted under this application.

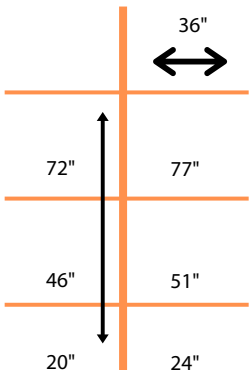
REMOVAL OF CRAFT FOR RACK REPAIR: The City will give you at least a one-week notice to remove your watercraft prior to any necessary rack repair. If the Parks Department has to remove the watercraft, there will be a \$50 fee to retrieve your canoe from storage and \$25 per month storage fee. Please call to arrange pickup. If the watercraft is not claimed after three months, the craft will be forfeited to the City and sold.

CANOE RACK RENTAL STICKERS: All watercraft must have the correct yearly stickers applied. Watercraft without stickers will be removed from the rack and placed in storage. There will be a \$50 fee to retrieve watercraft from storage and a \$25 per month storage fee. Please call to arrange pickup. If the watercraft is not claimed after three months, the craft will be forfeited to the City and sold.

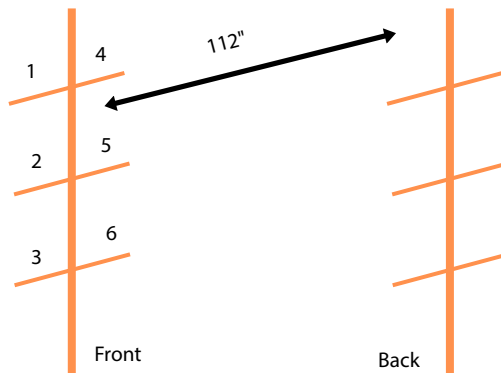
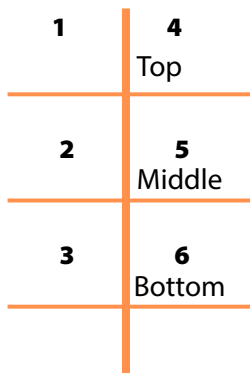
The height of this rack is slightly shorter on the front than the back. Boats cannot exceed the height of space between the racks.



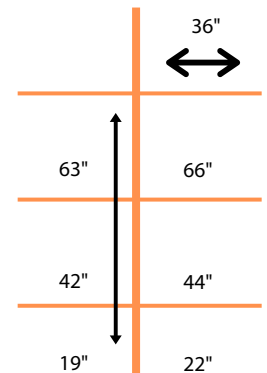
Orchard Lake Beach | 17195 Judicial Road



Rack A 1-6



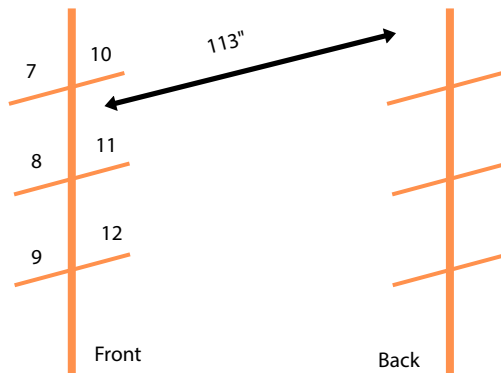
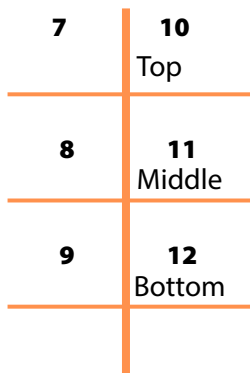

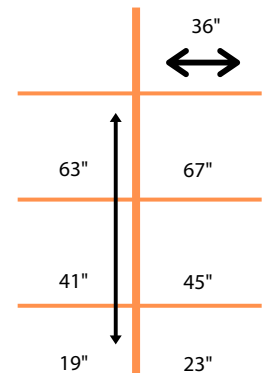

Rack B 7-12



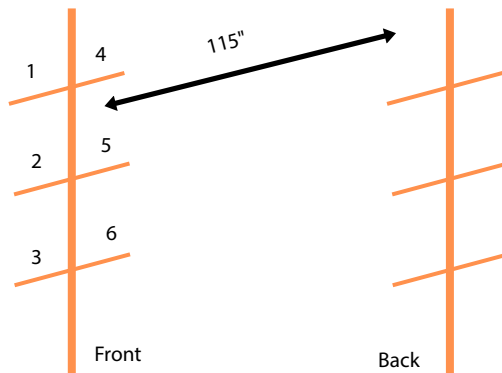
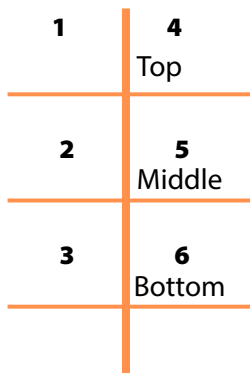

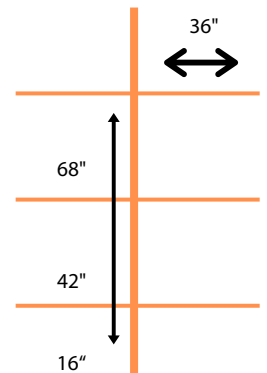
Casperson Park | 19720 Juno Trail



Rack A 1-6



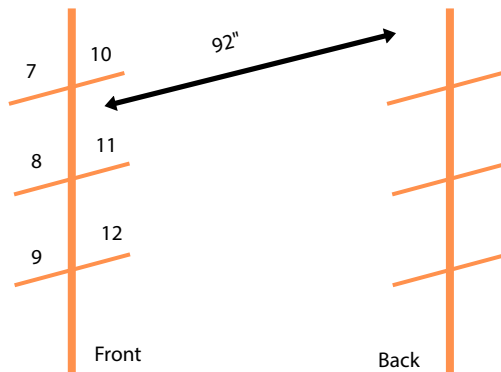
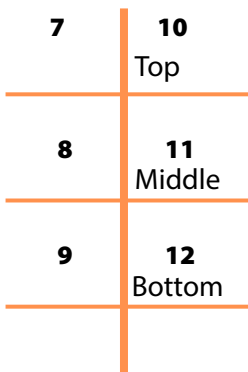
