Lakeville Parks & Recreation strives to make your experience as safe and fun as possible.

Please take a few moments to read through a series of new procedures below that have recently been implemented for our participants. The procedures cover the majority of the programs offered, however, specific policies may be outlined for some programs in a welcome letter you would receive prior to the start of the program.

Masks- For those not vaccinated, face masks are strongly recommended.

Pickup/drop-off procedures – Through May 27, 2021. We request that youth pickup/drop-off for indoor programs be limited to one adult accompanying the participant(s). Please adhere to 6-foot social distancing.

Hand sanitation – It is always a good idea to practice good hygiene. It is recommended that participants sanitize hands before and after programming.

Group sizes will be kept to Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) guidelines which remain in effect for indoor spaces only through May 27, 2021. Please maintain a 6-foot social distance from other patrons when indoors.

Illness and Exposure – A participant is required to stay home if they are [exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19](#) or if they have exposure to others with COVID-19 in order to prevent the spread of COVID-19 to other participants and instructors. If you have been tested for COVID-19 please follow the [Minnesota Department of Health's current guidelines regarding what to do after a COVID-19 test](#). The Parks & Recreation department has established a [COVID-19 Refund Policy](#) in case of illness and follow [Minnesota Department of Health \(MDH\) guidelines regarding how long to stay home](#). If you have tested positive for COVID-19 and have participated in Parks & Recreation program, we would appreciate it if you contact our office as soon as possible.
